ALL SAINTS DAY AND ALL SOULS DAY

Monday November 1 All Saints Day

The Feast Day was instituted to honour all the Saints, according to Urban IV (c. 1195-1264), to make up for any deficiencies in the faithfuls celebration of saint's feast days during the year.

In the early days the Christians were accustomed to solemnize the anniversary of a martyr's death for Christ at the place of martyrdom. In the persecution of Diocletian the number of martyrs became so great that a separate day could not be assigned to each. But the Church, feeling that every martyr should be venerated, appointed a common day for all. Gregory IV (827-844) extended the celebration on 1 November to the entire Church. The vigil, known as 'Halloween' seems to have been held as early as the feast itself.

Tuesday November 2 All Souls Day

All Souls Day commemorates the faithful departed, those baptized Christians believed to be in purgatory. Purgatory still exists in Church teaching—it is "the state of those who die in God's friendship, assured of their eternal salvation, but who still have need of purification to enter into the happiness of heaven". (Compendium of the Catechism, n. 210) The day purposely follows All Saints Day in order to shift the focus from those in heaven to those in purgatory.

Park will be held on Sunday, **7th November** at **2.30pm**. You are all invited to attend and pray for all our loved ones; especially those who have lost a loved one this year and or have a loved one resting in that cemetery.
