As we move further into the Church Year and the Christmas celebrations give way to 'Ordinary Time' we continue to find ourselves in extraordinary times. However, the readings for this Sunday give us hope and comfort as we celebrate Jesus Christ's life of service and ministry.

What is Ordinary Time

The rhythm of the liturgical seasons reflects the rhythm of life - with its celebrations of anniversaries and its season of quiet growth and maturing.

Ordinary Time, meaning ordered or numbered time, is celebrated in two segments: from the Monday following the Baptism of Our Lord up to Ash Wednesday; and from Pentecost Monday to the First Sunday of Advent. This makes it the largest season of the Liturgical Year.

In vestments usually green, the colour of hope and growth, the Church counts the thirty-three or thirty-four Sundays of Ordinary Time, inviting her children to meditate upon the whole mystery of Christ - His life, miracles and teachings - in the light of His Resurrection.

If the faithful are to mature in the spiritual life and increase faith, they must descend the great mountain peaks of Easter and Christmas in order to 'pasture' in the vast verdant meadows of *tempus per annum* or Ordinary Time.

Sunday by Sunday, the Pilgrim Church marks her journey through the *tempus per annum* as she processes through time toward eternity.

In a special manner, it enables us to give focus to our children, the youth and the challenges they face in these modern times.

*Sinolog is the ritual prayer-dance honouring Señor Santo Niño or the Child Jesus. An image of the Child Jesus is said to be the baptismal gift the Portuguese conquistador Ferdinand Magellan gave Hara Amihan (Humanay) of Zebu (now Cebu) in April 1521.

Parish Religious Education Program, 2022

St Andrew's, Clarkson Parish offers the Parish Religious Education Program (PREP) mandated by the Catholic Archdiocese of Perth. PREP is a comprehensive developmental and sequential Religious Education program designed especially for children who are attending Non-Catholic Schools. PREP also includes the preparation of children to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. PREP classes are held every Wednesday during the school terms from 3.45pm to 4.45pm. Classes this year will be held in the St Andrew's CPS Hall.

Please note the commencement of classes will be as follows:

- Reconciliation classes will be on Thursday 27 January at 4pm for children in Year 3 - 6 and for all students who completed the Pre-Sacramental year in 2021.
- All other children can be enrolled on Wednesday 2 February at 3.45pm with classes commencing the following week - Wednesday 8 February at 3.45pm
