### May the Month of Mary

The month of May is the "month which the piety of the faithful has especially dedicated to Our Blessed Lady," and it is the occasion for a "moving tribute of faith and love which Catholics in every part of the world (pay) to the Queen of Heaven. During the month Christians, both in church and in the privacy of the home, offer up to Mary from their hearts an especially fervent and loving homage of prayer and veneration. In this month, too, the benefits of God's mercy come down to us from her throne in greater abundance." This Christian custom of dedicating the month of May to the Blessed Virgin arose at the end of the 13<sup>th</sup> Century. In this way, the Church was able to Christianise the secular feasts which were to take place at that time. In the 16<sup>th</sup> Century, books appeared and fostered this devotion.

**During the Month of May the Church asks us to pray the Rosary - Our Lady's favourite prayer. Please try to pray the Rosary with your family and friends each day during May.**

#### A Prayer to Mary

O Mary, my mother,  
I offer you my soul, my mind and my heart.  
Make me God's instrument.

Give me a penetrating mind to discover,  
firm to judge, free to serve the truth;

An honest mind in telling what it sees rather than what it wants to see;

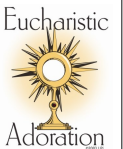


### Eucharistic Adoration on Fridays

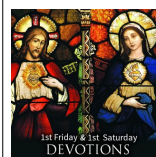
