May the Month of Mary

As we continue on in the month of May, the "month which the piety of the faithful has especially dedicated to Our Blessed Lady." It is the occasion for a "moving tribute of faith and love which Catholics in every part of the world (pay) to the Queen of Heaven. During this month Christians, both in church and in the privacy of the home, offer up to Mary from their hearts an especially fervent and loving homage of prayer and veneration. In this month, too, the benefits of God's mercy come down to us from her throne in greater abundance." This Christian custom of dedicating the month of May to the Blessed Virgin arose at the end of the 13th Century. In this way, the Church was able to Christianise the secular feasts which were to take place at that time. In the 16th Century, books appeared and fostered this devotion.

There are many ways, as a Church and in your homes to honour Our Blessed Lady, here are few simple ways:

1. Flower your Mary Statue - if you have a statue of Mary in your home, adorn the statue with fresh blooming flowers, or add an extra candle.
2. Pray a novena to Our Lady - pray a novena to Our Blessed Mother for a particular intention that you want to entrust to her Immaculate Heart for yourself or someone else.
3. Spread the devotion of the Rosary - outside of the Mass, there is no prayer more pleasing to Our Lady and more efficacious for her intercession than the Holy Rosary. If you don't already have the spiritual discipline, make an effort to pray the rosary daily.
4. Learn about a new Marian devotion - Our Lady is the Mother of the Universal Church and there are many ways she has affected Christians in various times and places, since she walked the earth.
5. Memorize a Marian Prayer or Hymn - these prayers and hymns become a great solace during trying moments and can be recited often.
6. Read a book about Mary - the best way to increase your devotion to the Blessed Mother is simply by reading more about her.
