### THINGS FOR US CATHOLICS TO REMEMBER

#### Eucharistic Fast

Those who receive Communion are to abstain for one hour beforehand from all food and drink with the exception of water and medicine. This does not apply to the elderly, the sick and those who care for them, or to priests celebrating a second or third Mass on a given day. It is most strongly recommended that the faithful receive Holy Communion in the course of a Eucharistic celebration.

#### Friday Penance

Friday is a traditional day of penance and should be marked by:

**Prayer**—participating in the Eucharist, family prayer, visiting a church, reading the scriptures, making the Way of the Cross, praying the Rosary;

**Self denial**—abstaining from meat, sweets or desert, giving up entertainment to spend time with the family, limiting food and drink in support of the poor;

**Helping others**—giving special attention to someone who is sick, poor, elderly, lonely or overburdened.
