### REFUGEE AND MIGRATION SUNDAY

On this occasion Pope Francis says, "We need to become aware that the phenomenon of migration is not unrelated to salvation history, but rather a part of that history. One of God's commandments is connected to it: "You shall not wrong a stranger or oppress him, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt" (EX 22:21); "Love the sojourner therefore; for you were sojourners in the land of Egypt" (Deut 10:19) This phenomenon constitutes a sign of the times...While appreciating the issues...as to, the difficulties with the demands of offering a dignified welcome to these persons, the Church nevertheless...invites us to do this precisely amidst this phenomenon, with the certainty that no one is a stranger in the Christian community. Which embraces every nation, tribe, people and tongue" (Rev 7:9). We give thanks for the variety of gifts with which our migrant and refugee brother and sisters have enriched the tapestry of Australian life. We pray that Australians will work together to "welcome the stranger".
