THE SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING

The Feast of Christ the King was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living and organizes his life as if God did not exist. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's royalty over individuals, families, society, governments, and nations. Today's Mass establishes the titles for Christ's royalty over men:



1. Christ is God, the Creator of the universe and hence wields a supreme power over all things; "All things were created by Him";
2. Christ is our Redeemer, He purchased us by His precious Blood, and made us His property and possession;
3. Christ is Head of the Church, "holding in all things the primacy";
4. God bestowed upon Christ the nations of the world as His special possession and dominion.

ADVENT SEASON

—begins Sunday 27/28 November

Next weekend we will be commencing a new liturgical year, Advent season. During the Advent Season families should spend time together preparing for the approaching celebration of the birth of Christ. An Advent Wreath can be a great focal point for family prayers and holiday celebrations. The Advent wreath is a wreath of laurel, spruce or similar foliage with four candles that are lighted successively in the weeks of Advent to symbolize the light that the birth of Christ brought into the world. Traditionally three of the candles are purple, the colour of the kings and penance. A rose-coloured candle is used to mark the Third Sunday of Advent as a time to rejoice over the closeness of Christmas and the coming of Christ.

One of our Parish Family will be invited to light up the Advent Candle one the Advent Wreath at the beginning of each Sunday Mass during the Advent Season.

Uses of Holy Water Every Catholic Should Know
Holy water is a common fixture in Catholic churches but have you ever wondered why the water in it is considered holy? Most probably, you didn't. Not many of us do. Holy water is something that we often take for granted, even though it's a very important catholic symbol.
As a sacramental, the holy water plays a huge role in several Catholic rites. It signifies repentance, rebirth, commitment, and devotion among other things. By virtue of Christ's baptism, that water has become an instrument of God's grace.
Common Uses of Holy Water
There is no limit as to where you can use holy water. It's after all a symbol of God's grace. You can use it on almost anything, for protecting your family from evil to blessing everyday objects.
How To Use Holy Water
Obviously, you cannot make holy water on your own. It has to be consecrated by a priest. So you can only get holy water from church. Some churches give out small bottles of holy water to anyone who asks for it. Alternatively, you can take some water to the church and ask your priest to bless it. Any water will do. There's no standard prayer to utter when sprinkling the holy water. But you can utter a simple prayer like:
"By this holy water and by Your precious Blood, was away all my sins, O Lord. Amen."
Since we are not allowed to bless ourselves with holy water the traditional way from now on starting the First Sunday in Advent, next weekend Fr Darek or Fr Marian will be sprinkling holy water on parishioners at the beginning of Mass so then they will be able to bless themselves with holy water.
