The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord Wednesday 2 February



On Wednesday 2 February, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and the Feast of the Purification of our Lady in the Temple at Jerusalem. Their offering was later to find complete and perfect fulfillment in the mystery of the passion, death and Resurrection of the Lord. The liturgy of the day opens with the blessing of the candles and the procession to the altar to meet Christ and to recognise Him in 'the breaking of the bread' until He comes again in glory.

The Feast proclaims Christ as the Light of the World. The event we are celebrating takes us back to what Mary and Joseph did, when 40 days after the birth of Jesus they presented their child to God as their firstborn, so complying with the Law of Moses.

At the Presentation in the Temple, Mary, the faithful Virgin who took part with Him in the eternal plan of salvation, was with Him as He was on Calvary.

The traditional liturgy for the day is called Candlemas, because of its ancient rite of blessing of the candles to be used for the next year - a practice dated from the middle of the 5th Century.

The World Day of Consecrated Life - Wednesday 2 February

The celebration of the World Day of Consecrated Life, which is observed on 2nd February, is intended to help the entire Church to esteem ever more greatly the witness of those persons who have chosen to follow Christ by means of the practice of chastity, obedience and poverty. It is intended to be a suitable occasion for consecrated persons to renew their commitment.

The mission of the consecrated life in the present and in the future of the Church, concerns not merely those who have received this special charism, but the entire Christian community.

Let us remember in our prayers this week all religious and priests, especially the Salvatorian Fathers, brothers and sisters who have assisted us in our life journey.

St Blaise Feast Day Mass with Blessing of the throat - Thursday 3 February, 10am in the RAAFA Chapel




On the 3rd of February each year, the Church celebrates the Feast of St Blaise. On this day the blessing of St Blaise is given: two candles are blessed, generally by a prayer, these are then held in a crossed position by a priest over the heads of the faithful or people are touched on the throat by them as a blessing is said. St Blaise's protection of those with throat troubles apparently comes from a legend that a boy, who had a fishbone stuck in his throat was brought to him. The boy was about to die when St Blaise healed him.

Very few facts are known about St Blaise. We know that he was a bishop of Sebastea in Armenia who was martyred under the reign of Licinius in the early 4th Century. The legend of his life that sprang up in the 8th Century tell us that he was born in to a rich and noble family who raised him as a Christian. After becoming a Bishop, a new persecution of Christians began. Blaise was eventually killed by the governor.

“Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness, in the name of the Father, and the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. “
