30th World Day of the Sick - Friday 11 February

**"Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful" (Lk 6:36).
Standing beside those who suffer on a path of charity**

Since 1992, the Catholic Church has celebrated World Day of the Sick on the 11th of February - the day on which the Church commemorates the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes*. Under Pontifical Council for Health Pastoral Care, World Day of the Sick has three consistent themes. First, it reminds the faithful to pray intensely and sincerely for those who are sick. Second, the celebration invites Christians to reflect on and respond to human suffering. And third, this day recognizes and honors all persons who work in health care and serve as caregivers.

* The 11th of February marks the first apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary in 1858 to 14 year old Marie Bernadette (St Bernadette) Soubirous. The Blessed Virgin appeared 18 times between 11 February and 16 July, 1858. She showed herself to St Bernadette in the hollow of the rock at Lourdes. On 25 March, the Blessed Virgin said to Bernadette, "I am the Immaculate Conception." Since then Lourdes has become a place of pilgrimage and many cures and conversions have taken place. St. Scholastica was the sister of St. Benedict and consecrated her life to God from her earliest youth. She helped her brother found a community of religious women about five miles south of St. Benedict's monastery in Monte Cassino. Scholastica and Benedict visited together only once a year and would spend the day praying and speaking of God and the spiritual life.
