### 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent Reflection - Weekend of 2 & 3 April



Many of us wear glasses, perhaps just for reading. Can you think back to the first pair of glasses you ever received? You might have been still at school or maybe older. If you think back to the first time you used a magnifying glass? Or perhaps looked through a microscope and saw that even such an ordinary thing as a leaf has all sorts of veins and colours? Seeing clearly is a great gift. We often take our eyesight for granted.

Today's readings reminds us of the importance of trying to see things clearly, which means not being taken in by false appearances. Jesus asks us if a blind person can lead another blind person. They will both fall into a pit. He might not mean blind in the literal sense. Anybody familiar with the work of Vision Australia will know that people with a sight deficit can surely help each other. But those who are blinded by their ego or self-importance or status or wealth are in a lot of bother. Those who are harsh in the way they judge others are even worse off. Nobody can forget the image Jesus uses of removing the plank from your own eye before commenting on the splinter in somebody else's. Jesus did not like hypocrites. He would have agreed with the words we heard from Ecclesiasticus that we are judged by the quality of our fruit. The things we say are a sign of our character. It is good to think about this in age where it is easy to say thoughtless and nasty and destructive things. The right words at the right time make a big difference.

**Prayer For Ukraine**  
We turn to you, Lord Jesus Christ, Word of God made flesh for us, and we entrust the people of Ukraine to you who once said to your disciples, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you" (Jn 14:27). Hear the cry of your people; change the hearts of those who have unleashed such suffering on the innocent; strengthen the resolve of those who are working to bring the conflict to an end; be close to those who have been driven from their homes and from their homeland; heal the wounds of mind and heart inflicted on the children; comfort the frightened and the lost; strengthen the faith of those who are bereaved; give eternal rest and joy to those who have died. In your agony on the cross you entrusted your mother to the beloved disciple, entrusted him and all disciples to your mother's care (Jn 19:26). It was through Mary's faith that you, the Word made flesh, came to dwell among us. That same faith strengthened Mary as she stood at the foot of the cross. We pray that your suffering people in Ukraine may know and experience that Mary stands with them, too, in this time of their great distress. You have given Mary to us as the Mother of the Church and the Help of Christians. With great confidence in the power of her communion with our bishop and all the Holy People of God, we consecrate and entrust the people of Ukraine to Mary and ask that our prayers might be joined with hers as we come before you now in hope and in trusting faith. Hear our prayers, O Lord, and raise up champions of peace, of justice and of healing, so that the weapons of war may be silenced and the people of Ukraine may know the peace that only you can give.

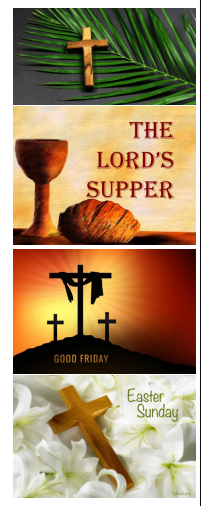
