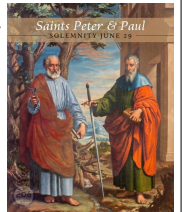

Feasts of St Peter and St Paul - Wednesday 29 June

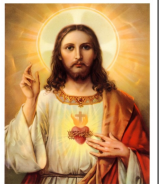
The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, is a feast commemorating the martyrdom in Rome of the apostles St Peter and Paul of Tarsus, observed on the 29th of June. The Celebration is of ancient origin, the date selected being either the anniversary of their death or the translation of their relics. This day commemorates the martyrdom of the two great Apostles, assigned by tradition to the same day of June in the year 67. They had been imprisoned in the famous Mamertine Prison of Rome and both had foreseen their approaching death. Saint Peter was crucified; St Paul, a Roman citizen, was slain by the sword. They were the two men around whom the mission of Jesus was to establish the Kingdom was centred and from whom it grew and spread to every corner of the world.

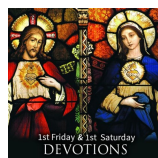
Annual Salvatorian Appeal - Thank you
