## ANNOUNCEMENTS & EVENTS

### Corpus Christi (The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ)

In this celebration we proclaim our belief in the Real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. We also proclaim that same Jesus lives within each one of us who are baptised into His Body, the Church. In the Holy Eucharist we receive the Divine Host whom we carry in procession. Through our Baptism He has taken up residence within each one of us. We carry Him into the real world just as we carry the monstrance into its streets today. When we process we proclaim that the Lord continues to come into the world, through us. The celebration of this Solemnity goes back to the 13<sup>th</sup> Century. Pope Urban IV instituted it in 1264 for the entire Church. He wanted it to be filled with joy and accompanied by hymns and a festive procession. He asked the great Western Church father, St Thomas Aquinas, to compose two Offices of prayer. St Thomas did so, alone with five hymns - and they have nourished the piety of Christians for centuries.

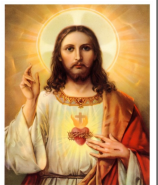


### The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus - Friday 24 June

First celebrated in 1760, in Rennes, France, through the efforts of Fr Jean Eudes. 'The Life story of Jesus as found in the Gospels is a story of a heart full of sympathy. - "And seeing the multitudes, He had compassion on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd" (Mark 6:34). How wonderfully He showed His sympathy and understanding towards discouraged sinners; towards the sorrowing widow of Naim, towards the children who flocked to Him, His treatment of the woman taken in adultery; the repentant thief; the ashamed Peter; the parable of the Good Shepherd and the Prodigal Son. No wonder people listened when He invited them; "Come to me all who labour and are burdened, and I will give you rest".'

#### The Prayer to the Sacred Heart

*O Lord Jesus Christ, to Your most Sacred Heart I confide this intention (name petition). Only look upon me, then do what Your love inspires. Let Your Sacred Heart decide. I count on You. I trust in You. I throw myself on Your mercy. Lord Jesus, You will not fail. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in You. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I believe in Your love for me. Sacred Heart of Jesus, Your kingdom come. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I have asked many favours, but I earnestly implore this one. Take it, place it in Your open Heart. When the Eternal Father looks upon it, He will see it covered with Your Precious Blood. It will be no longer my prayer, but Yours, Jesus. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you. Let me not be disappointed.*

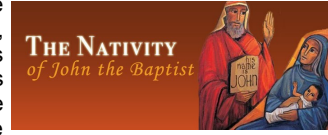

**Solemnity of the Nativity of St John the Baptist - Saturday 25 June**  
 Jesus call John the greatest of all those who had preceded him: "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John..." John spent his time in the desert as an ascetic. He began to announce the coming of the Kingdom, and to call everyone. His purpose was to prepare the way for Jesus. His Baptism, he said, was for repentance. But One would come who would baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. John is not worthy even to carry His sandals. His attitude towards Jesus was "He must increase, I must decrease" (John 3:30). John was humbled to find among the crowd of sinners who came to be baptised the One whom he already knew to be the Messiah. "I need to be baptised by you" (Matthew 3:14b). But Jesus insisted, "Allow it for now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfil all righteousness" (Matthew 3:15b). Jesus, true and humble human as well as eternal God, was eager to do what was required of any good Jew. John thus publicly entered the community of those awaiting the Messiah. But making himself part of that community, he made it truly messianic. John attracted countless people ("all Judea") to the banks of the Jordan, and it occurred to some people that he might be the Messiah. But he constantly deferred to Jesus, even to sending away some of his followers to become the first disciples of Jesus. John himself would share in the pattern of messianic suffering, losing his life to the revenge of Herodias.
