### 2nd World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly - Sunday 24 July

*"They shall bear fruit even in old age" (Psalm 92:15)*

Pope Francis established a World Day of Grandparents & the Elderly which took place for the first time on Sunday 25 July 2021. In 2022, the celebration will fall on this Sunday 24 July, the Sunday closest to the Feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, Grandparents of Jesus. The theme chosen by the Pope: "In old age they will bear fruit" (Psalm 92:15), to emphasise how grandparents and the elderly are a value and a gift both for society and for ecclesial communities.

The elderly must not be forgotten, the pastoral care of the elderly is a priority that can no longer be postponed by any Christian community. Place the elderly at the centre of the life of our communities every day. Ensure "no one lives this day in loneliness."

#### Prayer for Grandparents and the Elderly

Lord Jesus,

Help families and society to value the presence and role of grandparents and the elderly.

May they never be ignored or excluded, but always encounter respect and love.

Help them to live serenely and to feel welcomed

in all the years of life which you give them.

Holy Spirit, we know that some are lonely; please help us a Church family to reach out to the elderly and surround them with the love of the Father. Amen



#### Feast & Memorial Days this week

##### Feast of St James, apostle - Monday 25 July

Son of Zebedee and brother of John the Evangelist and Apostle. Known as James the Greater because of his status, he has been specially honoured since the 9th Century at Compostela in Spain.

##### Memorial of Sts Joachim and Anne, parents of Mary - Tuesday 26 July

An ancient tradition recorded in the Proto-Gospel of St James, an apocryphal work dating from A.D. 130-150, identifies Mary's parents as Joachim and Anne. The grandparents of Jesus were honoured in Jerusalem, where a Church of St Anne has existed since the Crusades.

##### Memorial of St Martha - Friday 29 July

Sister of Mary and Lazarus, who received the Lord with hospitality into their home in Bethany. Martha diligently waited on the Lord and with expectant faith beseeched the return of her brother from the dead.
