St. Mary of the Cross (MacKillop) Solemnity - Monday 8 August National Patronal Feast

Mary MacKillop was born in 1842 in (Fitzroy) Melbourne. On 8th August 1909 she died having suffered a disabling stroke in 1902. Inspired by a meeting with Fr. Julian Tenison-Woods, Mary MacKillop at the age of 25 years, took her vows and the religious name, 'Mary of the Cross'. In doing so, she founded the congregation of the Sisters of St Joseph. Soon after taking her religious vows, Mary MacKillop began schools. Within 5 years of taking her vows and founding the Congregation of the Sisters of St Joseph, Mary had established over 30 schools, in South Australia and over 100 women had joined the Sisters of St Joseph. Mary MacKillop was very conscious of the plight of the poor and needy. She worked with families that lived in isolate areas of Australia. As a result, Mary MacKillop pioneered a new form of religious life in Australia and commenced a 'system' of 'Josephite' schools that would provide education, especially for the children of the poor.

She was noted for her trust in the providence of God and miracles of healing have been attributed to her. She was declared a Saint by Pope Benedict XVI on the 17th October 2010.
