### Feast of St Matthew, apostle - Wednesday 21 September

Matthew was also known as Levi and son of Alphaeus, was a Galilean. A tax-gatherer at Capernaum, he was despised by the Pharisees. When summoned by Jesus, Matthew got up and followed Him. At a feast in his house, tax-gatherers and sinners sat at table with Christ and His disciples. This drew forth a protest from the Pharisees whom Jesus rebuked in these consoling words: 'I came not to call the just, but sinners.'

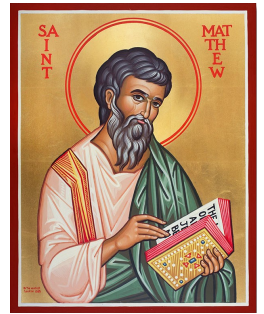
Matthew's Gospel is given pride of place in the canon of the New Testament, and was written to convince Jewish readers that their anticipated Messiah had come in the person of Jesus.
