### 108 World Day of Migrants and Refugees - Sunday 25 September

#### Building the Future with Migrants and Refugees

*"Here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come." (Heb 13:14)*

Pope Francis has chosen 'Building the Future with Migrants and Refugees,' as the theme for the 108th World Day of Migrants and Refugees 2022. On this day we are called to remember the difficult journeys that people have to make, and how it can be to start again in a new country. We also remember the gifts of all the different cultures and how they have enriched our lives in Australia. Pope Francis calls this 'beautiful diversity'. In his letter for the World Day of Migrants and Refugees, he asks us to build the future together with migrants and refugees, a place of inclusion and harmony, so it ends up looking just like the Kingdom of God.
