The Solemnity of Christ the King

The Feast of Christ the King was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living and organizes his life as if God did not exist. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's royalty over individuals, families, society, governments, and nations. Today's Mass establishes the titles for Christ's royalty over men:

- 1) Christ is God, the Creator of the universe and hence wields a supreme power over all things; "All things were created by Him";
- 2) Christ is our Redeemer, He purchased us by His precious Blood, and made us His property and possession;
- 3) Christ is Head of the Church, "holding in all things the primacy";
- 4) God bestowed upon Christ the nations of the world as His special possession and dominion.

ADVENT SEASON - begins Sunday 26/27 November

Next weekend we will be commencing a new liturgical year, Advent season. During the Advent season families should spend time together preparing for the approaching celebration of the birth of Christ. An Advent Wreath can be a great focal point for family prayers and holiday celebrations. The Advent wreath is a wreath of laurel, spruce or similar foliage with four candles that are lighted successively in the weeks of Advent to symbolize the light that the birth of Christ brought into the world. Traditionally three of the candles are purple, the colour of the kings and penance. A rose-coloured candle is used to mark the Third Sunday of Advent as a time to rejoice over the closeness of Christmas and the coming of Christ.

Lighting of the Advent Candle

One of our parish Family will be invited to light up the Advent Candle or the Advent Wreath at the beginning of each Sunday Mass during the Advent Season.

Holy Water in Advent

There will be NO sprinkling of Holy Water over the congregation at the beginning of each Mass during the season of Advent. Parishioners are encouraged to use the Holy Water Font to bless themselves which is located in the Church foyer.

Eucharistic Adoration

Every Friday from 8.30am - 4pm, with the Divine Mercy Chaplet recited at 3pm.
