The early church faced a difficult first challenge. Persecutors like Saul attacked believers, put them in jail, and they even killed some of them. Saul spoke "murderous threats" ([Acts 9:1](#)) and made evil plans against the Lord's disciples. But Jesus changed Saul's plans and chose him to become one of His greatest missionaries...As a "chosen instrument," Paul proclaimed the Gospel "to the Gentiles and their kings and to the people of Israel."
