The Church in Australia celebrates the Sunday of the Word of God on the first Sunday in February – February 5 in 2023. Pope Francis established the day, which is devoted to "the celebration, study and dissemination" of the Word of God.

Visit www.catholic.org.au/wordofgodsunday to access resources to help commemorate the day and for suggestions on how to better engage with Sacred Scripture in various ways and settings.

For many decades, the Catholic Church in Australia has taken part in the National Bible Sunday organized on the third Sunday in July by Bible Society Australia. It is good that this is an ecumenical event since all Christian Churches hold the Scriptures in common. It is always listed among the special commemorations in the official Ordo, but has in recent times been largely ignored in many Catholic Parishes.

Word of God Sunday - Sunday 5 February

Towards the end of 2019, Pope Francis instituted a Sunday of the Word of God. This was put down for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. He chose this date because it is close to when the Week of Prayer of Christian Unity is celebrated in the Northern Hemisphere. This timing is quite impractical for Australia. The dates get mixed up with the final weeks of the Summer holidays, the return of school and celebration of Australia Day. This is why, many years ago, we moved the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity to the time between Ascension and Pentecost, which is generally in May.

This raised the question of our date of the Sunday of the Word of God. It cannot easily be near to the Christian Unity week because all the Sundays are taken up with Easter, Pentecost the Solemnities which follow. Should it coincide with National Bible Sunday in July? In any case, the Australian Bishops have decided to keep it close to Pope Francis' day, so it is held on the First Sunday in February.

Compassion as a synodal exercise of healing

Pope Francis' message for this year's World Day of the Sick*, urges Catholics to heed the example of the Good Samaritan; showing compassion and taking care of the sick in a world that discards the most vulnerable. As the Church journeys along the synodal path, Pope Francis is inviting the faithful to reflect on the fact that "it is especially through the experience of vulnerability and illness that we can learn to walk together according to the style of God, which is closeness, compassion, and tenderness".

* The Catholic Church marks World Day of the Sick annually on 11 February, the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes.

Scholastica, "She could do more because she loved more." (Source: www.lovolapress.com).


Prayer for the Family
