Easter Sunday Christ is Risen, Alleluia!

"The night has passed and the morning is at hand, so, cast away the deeds of the darkness and put on the armour of light be vested with our Lord Jesus Christ." (Rm 13:12)

Easter Season

Easter follows Holy Week and is the third and final day of the Paschal Triduum, the three day period Meluia which began on the evening of Holy Thursday. The evening prayer of Easter Day officially ends the Triduum. The Triduum contains the hear of the Christian faith: Jesus death and resurrection.

Easter is not just a day, but an entire fifty days season, called Eastertide, marked by joyful festivities and liturgical fullness. You might hear 'Christ is Risen' and 'Alleluia' frequently during the Easter Season, because we are joyfully celebrating Christ's bodily resurrection. The Feast of the Ascension falls within the Easter Season. The fifty day season of Easter runs up to, and includes the Feast of Pentecost!

Divine Mercy Sunday - next week Sunday 16 April

The Divine Mercy Feast is celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun reported visions and visitations from Jesus and conversations with Him. He asked her to paint the vision of His Merciful Divinity being poured from His Sacred Heart and specifically asked for a feast of Divine Mercy to be established on that day so mankind would take refuge in Him. Divine Mercy Sunday is a very special day when the Divine Floodgates from Heaven are wide-open and Jesus offers us the total forgiveness of all sins and punishment to any soul, who goes to Confession and receives Holy Communion, on that day.



There will be a special Divine Mercy Service with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 3pm on Sunday 16 April. Please come and join us to honour Jesus.
