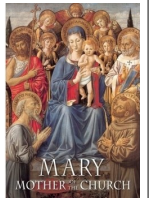

The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church - Monday 29 May

We honor Mary as Mother of the Church on the day after Pentecost reminding us that Mary was present with the disciples on Pentecost. Mary prayed with the first Christian community, awaiting the gift of the Holy Spirit for all believers. Mary prayed with them as the Holy Spirit descended. And Mary, our dear Mother, continues to pray for us. In 2018, Pope Francis added the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church to our Church calendar. Pope Francis hoped this devotion "might encourage the growth of the maternal sense of the Church in the pastors, religious and faithful."

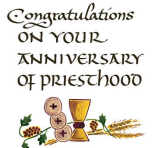
The Visitation of Mary - Wednesday 31 May

Each year the Universal Church celebrates the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary and recalls Mar's visit to her cousin Elizabeth. The event is recorded in Luke 1:39-50. Feeling the presence of the Saviour, John leaped within the womb of his mother, Elizabeth upon Mary's arrival: John was then filled with the grace of God. The Feast of the Visitation was first commemorated in the beginning of the 13th Century, when St Bonaventure recommended it, and the Franciscan chapter adopted it. The Franciscan breviary spread it to many churches, but it was only universally adopted in the 14th Century, when Pope Urban VI extended it.
