### June the month of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

#### The Prayer to the Sacred Heart

*O Lord Jesus Christ, to Your most Sacred Heart I confide this intention (name petition). Only look upon me, then do what Your love inspires. Let Your Sacred Heart decide. I count on You. I trust in You. I throw myself on Your mercy. Lord Jesus, You will not fail. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in You. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I believe in Your love for me. Sacred Heart of Jesus, Your kingdom come. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I have asked many favours, but I earnestly implore this one. Take it, place it in Your open Heart. When the Eternal Father looks upon it, He will see it covered with Your Precious Blood. It will be no longer my prayer, but Yours, Jesus. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you. Let me not be disappointed. Amen.*



### Solemnity of the Nativity of St John the Baptist - Saturday 24 June

Jesus call John the greatest of all those who had preceded him: "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John..." John spent his time in the desert as an ascetic. He began to announce the coming of the Kingdom, and to call everyone. His purpose was to prepare the way for Jesus. His Baptism, he said, was for repentance. But One would come who would baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. John is not worthy even to carry His sandals. His attitude towards Jesus was "He must increase, I must decrease" (John 3:30). John was humbled to find among the crowd of sinners who came to be baptised the One whom he already knew to be the Messiah. "I need to be baptised by you" (Matthew 3:14b). But Jesus insisted, "Allow it for now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfil all righteousness" (Matthew 3:15b). Jesus, true and humble human as well as eternal God, was eager to do what was required of any good Jew. John thus publicly entered the community of those awaiting the Messiah. But making himself part of that community, he made it truly messianic. John attracted countless people ("all Judea") to the banks of the Jordan, and it occurred to some people that he might be the Messiah. But he constantly deferred to Jesus, even to sending away some of his followers to become the first disciples of Jesus. John himself would share in the pattern of messianic suffering, losing his life to the revenge of Herodias.

At St Andrew's Parish **Eucharistic Adoration** is offered **every Friday 8.30am - 4pm**. During Eucharistic Adoration you are invited to pray in all sorts of ways; Meditative Prayer, Contemplative Prayer, silent conversation with Jesus, praying the Rosary, prayer journaling, reading Sacred Scripture or even just simply sitting and soaking up God's love in the presence of Jesus.
