
Feasts of St Peter and St Paul - Thursday 29 June

The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, is a feast commemorating the martyrdom in Rome of the apostles St Peter and Paul of Tarsus, observed on the 29th of June. The Celebration is of ancient origin, the date selected being either the anniversary of their death of the translation of their relics. This day commemorates the martyrdom of the two great Apostles, assigned by tradition to the same day of June in the year 67. They had been imprisoned in the famous Mamertine Prison of Rome and both had foreseen their approaching death. Saint Peter was crucified; St Paul, a Roman citizen, was slain by the sword. They were the two men around whom the mission of Jesus was to establish the Kingdom was centred and from whom it grew and spread to every corner of the world.


Eucharistic Adoration

Call for new Altar Servers

Following last weekend, children who have received their First Holy Communion are now able to become Altar Servers and support Father Darek, Father Marian, and the Acolytes at weekend Masses. This is a wonderful Parish Ministry for children to be a part of and a great way for them to grow deeper in their understanding of the Mass.



Children wanting to become an Altar Server need to complete a two-part training session. The Introductory session will take place on **Sunday 2 July at 10am**, immediately following the 9am Mass, lasting for approximately 40 minutes, with the second training session taking place on **Sunday 16 July** at the same time. Following their attendance at the two training sessions the new servers will be commissioned and will be able to begin their Ministry from August onwards. Children will be able to choose their preferred Mass (Saturday: 6pm, Sunday: 7.30am, 9am or 5pm) at which they would like to serve and will be rostered accordingly. Commissioned Altar Servers will also be able to serve at future School Masses.
