

ANNOUNCEMENTS & EVENTS

30th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A - Matthew 22:34-40

This week's Gospel follows close behind the Gospel read last Sunday. It is the last of three questions put to Jesus by Jewish religious leaders who are trying to trick him into saying something that might get him arrested. This reminds us that the context for today's reading is the mounting tension between Jesus and the religious leaders in Jerusalem. The Herodians and the Pharisees asked the first question, which was about taxes. The Sadducees asked the second question, which was about the Resurrection (see Matthew 22:22-33). The third question, considered in today's Gospel, is asked by a Pharisee who asks Jesus about the greatest of the commandments. The question requires Jesus to interpret the Law of Moses. The Mosaic Law consists of the Ten Commandments and many additional rules, numbering over six hundred. Adherence to the Mosaic Law, for a devout Jew, is an expression of faithfulness to God's covenant with Israel. The ranking of the Commandments was regularly debated among the teachers of the Law. Jesus answers the Pharisees' question with a two-fold summary. Jesus says that all of the commandments can be summarized in two commandments: love God and love your neighbor. Both of these were central elements of the religious tradition Jesus learned from his Jewish community. Indeed these continue to be central aspects of contemporary Jewish religious understanding. Jesus' response to his questioners proposed an integral connection between these two aspects of the Jewish Law. Love of God finds its expression in our love for our neighbour.

All Saints Day - Wednesday 1 November

The Feast Day was instituted to honour all the Saints, according to Urban IV (c.1195 - 1264), to make up for any deficiencies in the faithful's celebration of Saint's feast days during the year. In the early days the Christians were accustomed to solemnize the anniversary of a martyr's death for Christ at the place of martyrdom. In persecution of Diocletian the number of martyrs became so great that a separate day could not be assigned to each. But the Church, feeling that every martyr should be venerated, appointed a common day for all. Gregory IV (827 - 844) extended the celebration on 1 November to the entire Church. The vigil, known as 'Halloween' or Hallows Eve seems to have been held as early as the

All Souls Day - Thursday 2 November

All Souls Day commemorates the faithful departed, those baptised Christians believed to be in purgatory. Purgatory still exists in Church teaching - it is "the state of those who die in God's friendship, assured of their eternal salvation, but who still have need of purification to enter into the happiness of heaven." (Compendium of the Catechism, n. 210). The day purposely follows All Saints Day in order to shift the focus from those heaven to those in purgatory.

November - All Souls Month

November is the month of the Holy Souls. This is our opportunity to pray for the souls of our departed loved ones. All Morning Masses during the month of November will be offered for our departed loved ones mentioned on our special November envelopes. Envelopes for Mass offerings will


