Every Friday from 8.30am - 4pm, with the Divine Mercy Chaplet recited at 3pm.



Feast Days of the Week

Tuesday 26 December - St Stephen, the First Martyr

Stephen was one of the first group of seven deacons to be ordained in the early Church. Their role was to take care of the daily distribution of food to those in need. Falsely accused, Stephen was stoned to death but died praying for his executioners. See Acts of the Apostles Chapter 7 for an account of Stephen's speech before the Sanhedrin and for an account of his death.

Wednesday 27 December - St John, Apostle & author of John's Gospel John and his brother, James, were originally fishermen with their father Zebedee, in the Lake of Genneraset. With Peter and James, John shared a close relationship with Jesus and in the fourth Gospel he speaks of himself as 'the disciple whom Jesus loved'. John alone remained at the foot of the Cross on Calvary and at the invitation of Jesus took the Mother of Jesus into

Thursday 28 December - The Holy Innocents

The Gospel of Matthew tells the story: 'Then Herod perceiving that he was deluded by the wise men, was exceedingly angry: and sending killed all the male children that were in Bethlehem and in all the borders thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he diligently inquired of the wise men.
