Dear parishioners of St Andrew's Parish and Visitors,

We live in a bust world. So often we hear someone say "how time flies". It is so true that days, months and years have been passing so quickly. In a few moments we will celebrate once again what happened at Bethlehem 2000 years ago, when Jesus was born in a stable to bring humanity peace and joy. 

Feast Days of the Week

Tuesday 26 December - St Stephen, the First Martyr

Stephen was one of the first group of seven deacons to be ordained in the early Church. Their role was to take care of the daily distribution of food to those in need. Falsely accused, Stephen was stoned to death but died praying for his executioners. See Acts of the Apostles Chapter 7 for an account of Stephen's speech before the Sanhedrin and for an account of his death.

Wednesday 27 December - St John, Apostle & author of John's Gospel John and his brother, James, were originally fishermen with their father Zebedee, in the Lake of Genneraset. With Peter and James, John shared a close relationship with Jesus and in the fourth Gospel he speaks of himself as 'the disciple whom Jesus loved'. John alone remained at the foot of the Cross on Calvary and at the invitation of Jesus took the Mother of Jesus into his care.

Thursday 28 December - The Holy Innocents

The Gospel of Matthew tells the story: 'Then Herod perceiving that he was deluded by the wise men, was exceedingly angry: and sending killed all the male children that were in Bethlehem and in all the borders thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he diligently inquired of the
