### Divine Mercy Sunday - 7 April

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Sunday after Easter, the Octave of Easter, observed by Roman Catholic as well as some Anglicans. It is originally based on the Catholic Devotion to the Divine Mercy that Saint Faustina reported as part of her encounter with Jesus, and is associated with special promises from Jesus and indulgences issued by the Church.


The Feast of Divine Mercy, as recorded in the diary of Saint Faustina, receives from Jesus himself the biggest promises of grace related to the devotion of Divine Mercy. In specific, Jesus reputedly said that a person who does to sacramental confession (the confession may take place some days before) and receives Holy Communion on that day, shall obtain the total forgiveness of all sins and punishment. That means each person would immediately after death heaven without suffering purgatory (or hell). Additionally, the Roman Catholic Church grants a plenary indulgence (observing the usual rules) with the recitation of some simple prayers.

**The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be recited using a special audio format during Eucharistic Adoration at 3pm on Sunday 7 April. Please come and join us to honour Jesus.**

#### Divine Mercy Prayer

*Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.*

### Easter Season



Easter follows Holy Week and is the third and final day of the Paschal Triduum, the three day period which began on the evening of Holy Thursday. The evening prayer of Easter Day officially ends the Triduum. The Triduum contains the heart of the Christian faith: Jesus death and resurrection.

Easter is not just a day, but an entire fifty days season, called Eastertide, marked by joyful festivities and liturgical fullness. You might hear 'Christ is Risen' and 'Alleluia' frequently during the Easter Season, because we are joyfully celebrating Christ's bodily resurrection. The Feast of the Ascension falls within the Easter Season. The fifty day season of Easter runs up to, and includes the Feast of Pentecost!
