Corpus Christi (The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ)

In this celebration we proclaim our belief in the Real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. We also proclaim that same Jesus lives within each one of us who are baptised into His Body, the Church. In the Holy Eucharist we receive the Divine Host whom we carry in procession. Through our Baptism He has taken up residence within each one of us. We carry Him into the real world just as we carry the monstrance into its streets today. When we process we proclaim that the Lord continues to come into the world, through us. The celebration of this Solemnity goes back to the 13th Century. Pope Urban IV instituted it in 1264 for the entire Church. He wanted it to be filled with joy and accompanied by hymns and a festive procession. He asked the great Western Church father, St Thomas Aquinas, to compose two Offices of prayer. St Thomas did so, alone with five hymns - and they have nourished the piety of Christians for centuries.



The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus - Friday 7 June

First celebrated in 1760, in Rennes, France, through the efforts of Fr Jean Eudes. 'The Life story of Jesus as found in the Gospels is a story of a heart full of sympathy. - "And seeing the multitudes, He had compassion on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd" (Mark 6:34). How wonderfully He showed His sympathy and understanding towards discouraged sinners; towards the sorrowing widow of Naim, towards the children who flocked to Him, His treatment of the woman taken in adultery; the repentant thief; the ashamed Peter; the parable of the Good Shepherd and the Prodigal Son. No wonder people listened when He invited them; "Come to me all who labour and are burdened, and I will give you rest".'

The Prayer to the Sacred Heart

O Lord Jesus Christ, to Your most Sacred Heart I confide this intention (name petition). Only look upon me, then do what Your love inspires. Let Your Sacred Heart decide. I count on You. I trust in You. I throw myself on Your mercy. Lord Jesus, You will not fail. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in You. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I believe in Your love for me. Sacred Heart of Jesus, Your kingdom come. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I have asked many favours, but I earnestly implore this one. Take it, place it in Your open Heart. When the Eternal Father looks upon it, He will see it covered with Your Precious Blood. It will be no longer my prayer, but Yours, Jesus. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you. Let me not be disappointed. Amen.



Memorial of The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary - Saturday 8 June

The Immaculate Heart of Mary signifies, first of all, the great purity and love of the heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary for God. This is purity manifested in her "Yes" to the Father at the Incarnation, Her love for, and cooperation with, the Incarnate Son in His redemptive mission, and her docility to the Holy Spirit, enabling her to remain free of the stain of personal sin throughout her life. Mary's Immaculate Heart, therefore, points us to her profound interior life, where she experience both joys and sorrows, yet remained faithful, as we, too, are called to do.

Safeguarding at the Parish

- Personal Declaration Forms and Induction Session
Thank you to everyone that has already completed and returned their Personal Declaration forms. As a reminder, the Personal Declaration forms and the Safeguarding Induction are a requirement of the Archdiocese of Perth for parishioners who **support our Parish in any capacity, paid or unpaid, voluntary or formal employment**. It is also a timely reminder to monitor the expiry of your Working With Children status, if your work within the Parish also requires you to hold a valid and current card.

To assist with completing the Safeguarding Induction; **an in-person Safeguarding Induction Session will be held here at our Parish on Wednesday 19 June; 6pm - 7pm in St Andrew's CPS Hall**. Please note that if you are **unable** to attend the in-person session at our Parish, **there are several surrounding Parishes that are also holding in-person sessions and there is also the option to complete the Induction online via ZOOM**. The Induction session **takes no longer than 1 hour** whether in person or online. Once you have completed the induction - you are then only required to attend a Refresher Safeguarding Induction session in 3 years' time; in this case it will be in 2027 if completed this year. The induction provides an overview of the Safeguarding Policies and Procedures, the role of the Parish Safeguarding Officer, and the importance of Safeguarding within the parish.
